FRIENDS OF THE MANSFIELD LIBRARY

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

MEETINGS

- Section 1. The Friends shall meet annually on a date set by the Board for election of officers and transaction of other business.
- Section 2. A special meeting of this Association may be called at any time by the President or by a majority of the members of the board.
- Section 3. A written notice of each meeting shall be distributed to the membership at least one week prior to the meeting by U.S. mail or by email.

ARTICLE II

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

- Section 1. All officers shall be elected at the annual meeting and shall serve without compensation. The term of officers so elected shall begin with the annual meeting and continue until their successors are elected.
- Section 2. The officers of the Association shall be nominated by a committee of three members chosen by the Board.
- Section 3. The officers shall have all the usual powers and duties exercised by the officers of a voluntary association.
- Section 4. A vacancy in any office shall be filled for the remainder of the term through appointment by the Board.

ARTICLE III

COMMITTEES

The Board may authorize committees consistent with the purpose and resources of this Association.

ARTICLE IV

AMENDMENTS

These by-laws may be amended on prior notice at any meeting of this Association, by a two-third vote of the members present.
