# **Holiday Book Sales <**

ach December we put out on our sales shelf some of the many holiday books we receive as donations along with some of the small books and pamphlets that we label "small gifts and stocking stuffers." These books always sell so well that this year we decided to expand our holiday offerings. Right after Thanksgiving we set up a self-service table across from the circulation desk in the library and stocked it with gift-quality books and stocking stuffers. We received many positive comments and a good deal of cash – about \$700. We will be stockpiling books throughout this year and plan to have the sale again next December. We also are grateful that the Storrs Farmers Market allowed us to sell books at the two December markets. These sales netted about \$120 and were much appreciated by the shoppers as well as the vendors. We will be keeping a self-serve book case in the auditorium for the remainder of the indoor markets. Thanks to library director Leslie McDonough for coming up with the ideas for these additional sales opportunities and for helping to make them happen.
