We will no longer be accepting donations of VCR tapes. We are selling our remaining stock in the library and at the September book sale for ten cents each.

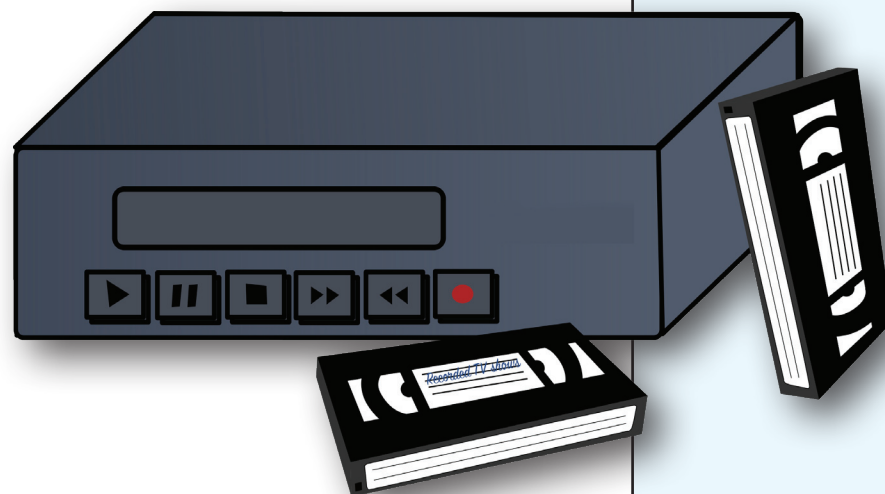
