Annual Meeting Scheduled

The Friends will hold its annual meeting on Monday November 8, 2021 at 7:00pm via Zoom. We are excited to have CT based artist Emida Roller to speak about the Racial Equity Mural to be installed in front of the Mansfield Community Center. The Town of Mansfield and the Human Rights Commission are partnering with the artist and CT Murals on the project.

All are invited to attend. There will be a short business meeting before the presentation. We will send an email with the meeting link to all members about a week before the meeting.
