

RENEW YOUR DUES

With the end of our fiscal year on September 30th, we remind you that it is time to renew your dues. Dues are important for funding our book sales which allow us to support the library. Dues remain at a very affordable \$10 per household, but you can always add an additional donation!

Some of the programs the Friends have helped to fund are the Summer Reading Challenge, adult crafts, the soon-to-arrive Toy Library, teen nights, a petting zoo and summer science fun. We hope you will continue to help the Friends support many more programs like these.

Help Needed for the Book Sale

We will be setting up the sale on Friday, September 6th. We will start at 1pm and work until 5pm and will need lots of volunteers to finish in that time. No lifting is required and anyone who volunteers can purchase up to 10 regular priced books that day.

We also need help cleaning up after the sale at 3pm on Sunday. This is a much faster process and usually takes about an hour if we have a lot of help. This also does not require lifting unless you are able.

Cashiers are needed on both days. We schedule 4-hour shifts with 2 people at each of 2 stations, so you never have to work alone. No experience is necessary and all books are priced at 50 cents or \$1.00 or multiples thereof, so no complex math is required.
